I had already been thinking of a new addition to the bulletin which was going to call Mass Reminders when I ran across this sheet of sixteen reminders. I have to give special attention to the last one, so please read #16 about leaving Mass immediately after receiving Holy Communion. Some people have to leave for medical or age reasons. But most of the time people leave Mass right after receiving Holy Communion for reason no other reason than impatience. Please don't leave Mass early. I see people leaving right from the Communion line and I can only assume that they don't know what the Eucharist is - Jesus really present. Otherwise you wouldn't receive the Body of Christ and leave church without taking the time to reflect and pray. Please don't leave Mass early. The Mass is not in fact even ended until the final blessing and the priest says "the Mass is ended, go in peace." Please don't leave Mass early.
