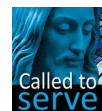
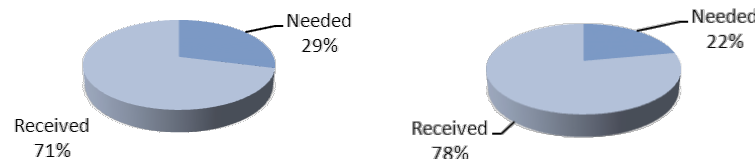


**Natural Family Planning**
