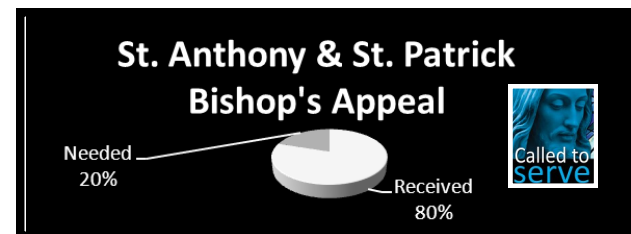
Prayer Chain
