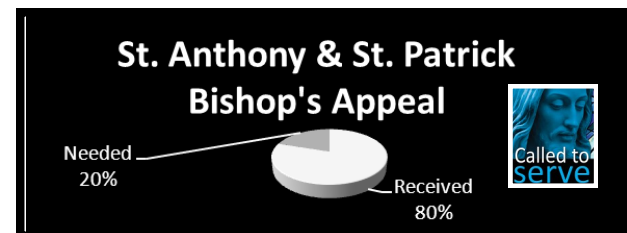
Pyx
