Father lived in New Holstein, where the family attended Seton Home Study School. He attended college at the University of St. Thomas and St. John Vianney Seminary, St. Paul, Minnesota, the University of St. Mary of the Lake Seminary, Mundelein, Illinois, and the North American College in Rome. Fr. Joel has a S.T.L. degree in Moral Theology. Father did his parish internship at Most Precious Blood Parish, New London. He was ordained a priest on June 30, 2007 at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral in Green Bay.

Fr. Joel's first assignment was as Parochial Vicar at St. Jude the Apostle and Most Blessed Sacrament Parishes, Oshkosh, and as Campus Minister at the Newman Center, Oshkosh. He is currently the Associate Pastor at St. Mary Catholic Community and St. Francis Xavier Parish in De Pere. Fr.
